Funeral Services Held For Emmetsburg Bank Executive Ed Norland

Lifetime Palo Alto County resident and long time Emmetsburg bank executive Edward C. Norland of Emmetsburg died Friday, Oct. 12, 1990, at Palo Alto County Hospital. He was 68.

Funeral services for Mr. Norland were held Monday, Oct. 15, at Bethany Lutheran Church in Emmetsburg. The Rev. Howard D. Vrankin officiated.

Burial was in Evergreen Cemetery, Emmetsburg. The Martin Funeral Home in Emmetsburg was in charge of arrangements.

Casket bearers were Adolph Spies, John F. Spies, S.J. Brownlee, Gary L. Hughes, William H. Stillman, Dennis V. Peterson, James Spies, Craig Brownlee and Kris Ausborn.

Edward C. Norland was born Feb. 9, 1922, in Cylinder, the son of Herman

and Gerda A. (Canton) Norland. He graduated from Cylinder High School; then attended Waldorf College and received his degree from Iowa State University. He also completed studies at the Graduate School of Banking at the University of Wisconsin.

After graduating from high school, Ed Norland started farming and he worked with his father at Norland & Son Hog-Buying-Station in Cylinder for many years. He began his banking career as an assistant cashier at Iowa Trust and Savings Bank in Emmetsburg in 1959.

On Sept. 17, 1960, Edward Norland and Beverly Hjelmervick were married at Frost, MN. The couple made their home in Emmetsburg. Mr. Norland retired Feb. 28, 1990, as Senior Vice President of Iowa Trust and Savings Bank, completing 30 years of service.

Mr. Norland had been interested in politics all of his adult life. He served one term in the Iowa House of Representatives in 1955, representing Palo Alto County.

In 1958 Ed Norland was a member of an Iowa Goodwill Farm Delegation to Russia. For 24 years, he served the City of Emmetsburg on the Municipal Utilities Board of Trustees.

Through the years Ed Norland fulfilled many community obligations, including president of the Emmetsburg Chamber of Commerce, a member of the Iowa State Extension Advisory Board and on the Iowa Bankers Association Board. For many years Mr. Norland served as treasurer of Lakeside Lutheran Home

in Emmetsburg. He was a former member of the Cylinder Lions Club.

Survivors include his wife, Beverly; and two children, Mark Norland of San Francisco, CA, and Mrs. Robert (April) McElwee of South Bend, IN. Also surviving are two sisters, Mrs. R.A. (Orlue) Regier of Dallas, OR and Mrs. Lester (Luetta) Rhodes of Grimes; and four brothers, Albert Norland and James Norland, both of Mankato, MN, Dr. Howard Norland of Lincoln, NE and Dr. Charles Norland of Davis, IL.

Mr. Norland was preceded in death by his parents and a brother, Gerald Norland.


