Mr. Ruehle died Saturday, Feb. 9, 1985, at Palo Alto County Hospital in Emmetsburg. He was 85.

Walter W. Ruehle was born June 20, 1899, in Graettinger. He was the son of Charles and Clara (Wessar) Ruehle.

On Feb. 25, 1928, Walter Ruehle and Edna Johnson were married in Emmetsburg. The couple farmed in the Ruthven area. The Ruehles retired in 1964 and continued to live on the farm. In 1978 Mr. Ruehle moved into the town of Ruthven, but retained an active interest in his farm.

Surviving are three children, Mrs. Barney (Shirley) Granstra of Everly, Harley Ruehle of Ruthven and Mrs. Howard (Joyce) Dixon of Ithaca, N.Y.; five grandchildren and one great grandson; and a brother, Clarence Ruehle of Ruthven.

Mr. Ruehle was preceded in death by his wife, Edna, on Aug. 9, 1971; his parents; two sisters, Edna and Florence; and two brothers, Elmer and John.

MESA, AZ — Ruthven native Arley H. Barringer of Mesa, Ariz., died Wednesday, Feb. 6, 1985, at the Mesa Lutheran Hospital. He was 87.

Services for Mr. Barringer were held Saturday, Feb. 9, at 1 p.m. at Trinity Baptist Church in Mesa. The Rev. Lanny Barringer and the Rev. David Falconer officiated.

Burial was in Mountain View Cemetery, Mesa. The Falconer Funeral Home in Gilbert, Ariz., was in charge of arrangements.

Arley H. Barringer was born Nov. 4, 1897, in Ruthven. He was the son of Cleborn and Alchra (Root) Barringer.

On Nov. 22, 1932, Arley Barringer and Viola Hansen were married. The couple farmed in the Ruthven area. Following their retirement, the Barringers moved to Arizona where they have lived for the past 22 years.

Mr. Barringer served in the Iowa House of Representatives from 1955-57 and on the Ruthven School Board for 10 years. He was a past member of the Lions Club in Ruthven and a member of the Flying Farmers

of Iowa. He had attended Trinity Baptist Church in Mesa since 1965.


Heart Memorials


