A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act concerning access to documents during the competitive
- 2 bidding process for public improvement contracts.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

H.F. 167

- 1 Section 1. Section 26.3, subsection 2, Code 2015, is amended 2 to read as follows:
- A governmental entity shall have an engineer licensed
- 4 under chapter 542B, a landscape architect licensed under
- 5 chapter 544B, or an architect registered under chapter 544A
- 6 prepare plans and specifications, and calculate the estimated
- 7 total cost of a proposed public improvement. A governmental
- 8 entity shall ensure that a sufficient number of paper copies,
- 9 and if available, electronic and digital copies of the
- 10 project's contract documents, including all drawings, plans,
- 11 specifications, and estimated total costs of the proposed
- 12 public improvement are made available for distribution at
- 13 no charge to prospective bidders, subcontractor bidders,
- 14 suppliers, and contractor plan room services. If a deposit is
- 15 required as part of a paper contract documents distribution
- 16 policy by the public owner, the deposit shall not exceed two
- 17 hundred fifty dollars per set which shall be refunded upon
- 18 return of the contract documents within fourteen days after
- 19 award of the project. If the contract documents are not
- 20 returned in a timely manner and in a reusable condition, the
- 21 deposit shall be forfeited. The governmental entity shall
- 22 reimburse the landscape architect, architect, or professional
- 23 engineer for the actual costs of preparation and distribution
- 24 of plans and specifications.
- 25 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 28 This bill prohibits governmental entities from charging
- 29 a fee for electronic and digital copiesof project contract
- 30 documents relating to public improvements when providing those
- 31 documents electronically.
