A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the licensure of child care programs
- operated or contracted for by a school district or
- 3 accredited nonpublic school and including effective date
- 4 provisions.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 237A.1, subsection 3, paragraph b, Code
- 2 2015, is amended by striking the paragraph.
- 3 Sec. 2. Section 279.49, subsection 1, Code 2015, is amended
- 4 by striking the subsection.
- 5 Sec. 3. Section 279.49, subsections 2 and 3, Code 2015, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 2. The board of directors of a school corporation may
- 8 operate or contract for the operation of a program to provide
- 9 child care to children not enrolled in school or to students
- 10 enrolled in kindergarten through grade six before and after
- 11 school, or to both. Programs operated or contracted by a board
- 12 shall either meet standards for child care programs adopted
- 13 by the state board of education or shall be licensed by the
- 14 department of human services under chapter 237A as a child
- 15 care center unless the program is exempt from licensure under
- 16 chapter 237A. A program operated by a board under contract
- 17 which is not located on property owned or leased by the board
- 18 must be licensed by the department of human services.
- 19 3. a. The person employed to be responsible for a program
- 20 operated or contracted by a board that is not licensed by the
- 21 department of human services shall be an appropriately licensed
- 22 teacher under chapter 272 or shall meet other standards adopted
- 23 by the state board of education collaborate with that board in
- 24 the operation of that program.
- 25 b. An employee of a program operated or contracted by a
- 26 board shall be subject to a background investigation at least
- 27 once every five years after the employee's initial date of
- 28 hire.
- 29 Sec. 4. Section 280.3A, Code 2015, is amended to read as
- 30 follows:
- 31 280.3A Accredited nonpublic school child care programs.
- 32 Authorities in charge of an accredited nonpublic schools
- 33 school may operate or contract for the operation of a child
- 34 care programs, as defined program, as described in section
- 35 279.49, subsection 1. The provisions of section 279.49 as

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- 1 they relate to child care programs of a school corporation and
- 2 its board of directors apply to the child care programs of the
- 3 accredited nonpublic school and the authority in charge.
- 4 Sec. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE AND IMPLEMENTATION. This Act takes
- 5 effect January 1, 2016, except that the department of human
- 6 services may begin implementation prior to January 1, 2016, to
- 7 the extent necessary to transition to full implementation of
- 8 the provisions of this Act.
- 9 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 12 Under current law, either the department of human services
- 13 (DHS) or the department of education (DE) is required to
- 14 license a child care program operated by or contracted for by a
- 15 school district or accredited nonpublic school to provide child
- 16 care to children not enrolled in school or to students enrolled
- 17 in kindergarten through grade six before and after school, or
- 18 to both.
- 19 The bill provides that DHS shall be the only state agency
- 20 responsible for the licensure of such child care programs and
- 21 requires DHS to issue such licenses.
- 22 The bill provides that an employee of a program operated
- 23 or contracted by a board shall be subject to a background
- 24 investigation at least once every five years after the
- 25 employee's initial date of hire.
- 26 Conforming Code changes are made striking Code section
- 27 237A.1, subsection 3, paragraph "b", relating to the definition
- 28 of "child care" for purposes of DHS licensure and DE child care
- 29 programs provided for under Code sections 279.49 and 280.3A,
- 30 striking references in Code section 279.49 relating to child
- 31 care programs not licensed or approved by DHS, and amended Code
- 32 section 280.3A relating to accredited nonpublic school child
- 33 care programs.
- The bill takes effect January 1, 2016, except that DHS may
- 35 begin implementation prior to that date.
