Section 1. Section 298.3, subsection 1, Code 2015, is
amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 <u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. n. (1) The repair of any of the following:
4 (a) Equipment or technology eligible to be purchased,
5 leased, or lease-purchased under paragraph "c".

6 (b) Transportation equipment eligible to be purchased under 7 paragraph i'.

8 (c) Recreational equipment eligible to be purchased under 9 paragraph k''.

10 (2) For the purposes of this paragraph, "repair" means 11 restoring an existing item of equipment or technology to 12 its original condition, as near as may be, after gradual 13 obsolescence or physical and functional depreciation due to 14 wear and tear, corrosion and decay, or partial destruction, and 15 includes maintenance of an item of equipment or technology. 16 Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to school budget 17 years beginning on or after July 1, 2015.

EXPLANATION

19The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with20the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

Current Code section 298.3 authorizes revenues from the regular and voter-approved physical plant and equipment levies to be used, in part, for the purchase, lease, or lease-purchase equipment or technology exceeding \$500 in value per purchase, lease, or lease-purchase transaction, the purchase of transportation equipment for transporting students, and the purchase of equipment for recreational purposes. This bill authorizes a school district to use revenues from the regular and voter-approved physical plant and equipment levies for the repair of such equipment and technology. The bill defines "repair".

32 The bill applies to school budget years beginning on or after 33 July 1, 2015.
