- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 272.31, subsection 1, Code 2015, is 1 2 amended by adding the following new paragraph: NEW PARAGRAPH. 0e. Successful completion of a certification 3 4 course for cardiopulmonary resuscitation and use of an 5 automated external defibrillator. Sec. 2. Section 279.19B, subsection 1, Code 2015, is amended 6 7 by adding the following new paragraph: NEW PARAGRAPH. Ob. An individual employed under paragraph 8 9 "a'' shall possess a valid certificate of completion of a 10 nationally recognized course in cardiopulmonary resuscitation ll and use of an automated external defibrillator. Sec. 3. APPLICABILITY PROVISIONS. A person who possesses 12 13 a valid teaching license with a coaching endorsement or a 14 coaching authorization issued by the board of educational 15 examiners prior to July 1, 2015, shall have until July 1, 2016, 16 to meet the requirements of this Act. EXPLANATION 17 18 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 19 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly. 20 This bill provides that an applicant for a coaching 21 authorization or coaching endorsement issued by the board 22 of educational examiners and a person employed by a school 23 district as a coach must possess a valid certificate of 24 completion of a nationally recognized course in cardiopulmonary 25 resuscitation and use of an automated external defibrillator. 26 A person who possesses a valid teaching license with a 27 coaching endorsement or a coaching authorization issued by the 28 board prior to July 1, 2015, shall have until July 1, 2016, to 29 meet the requirements of the bill.
