- 1 An Act providing for an exemption from municipal tort
- 2 liability for claims arising from tubing or sledding on
- 3 municipality-controlled property.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 670.4, subsection 1, paragraphs n and o, 2 Code 2015, are amended to read as follows:
- 3 n. Any claim based upon or arising out of a claim of
- 4 negligent design or specification, negligent adoption of design
- 5 or specification, or negligent construction or reconstruction
- 6 of a public facility designed for purposes of skateboarding,
- 7 in-line skating, bicycling, unicycling, scootering, river
- 8 rafting, canoeing, or kayaking, tubing, or sledding that was
- 9 constructed or reconstructed, reasonably and in good faith,
- 10 in accordance with generally recognized engineering or safety
- ll standards or design theories in existence at the time of the
- 12 construction or reconstruction.
- 0. Any claim based upon or arising out of an act or
- 14 omission of an officer or employee of the municipality or
- 15 the municipality's governing body by a person skateboarding,
- 16 in-line skating, bicycling, unicycling, scootering, river
- 17 rafting, canoeing, or kayaking, tubing, or sledding on public
- 18 property when the person knew or reasonably should have known
- 19 that the skateboarding, in-line skating, bicycling, unicycling,
- 20 scootering, river rafting, canoeing, or kayaking, tubing, or
- 21 sledding created a substantial risk of injury to the person
- 22 and was voluntarily in the place of risk. The exemption from
- 23 liability contained in this paragraph shall only apply to
- 24 claims for injuries or damage resulting from the risks inherent
- 25 in the activities of skateboarding, in-line skating, bicycling,
- 26 unicycling, scootering, river rafting, canoeing, or kayaking,
- 27 tubing, or sledding.
- 28 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 31 This bill provides an exemption from liability regarding
- 32 a municipality's negligent design or specification, or
- 33 negligent construction or reconstruction, of a public facility
- 34 designed for tubing or sledding purposes that was constructed
- 35 or reconstructed in accordance with generally recognized

- 1 engineering or safety standards or design theories.
- 2 The bill also provides an exemption from liability
- 3 for municipalities relating to claims based upon acts or
- 4 omissions of an officer or employee of the municipality by
- 5 a person engaged in tubing or sledding when the person knew
- 6 or reasonably should have known that the tubing or sledding
- 7 created a substantial risk of injury and the person was acting
- 8 voluntarily.
- 9 A municipality in Code chapter 670 is defined as a city,
- 10 county, township, school district, or other unit of local
- 11 government.
