## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the school start date and eliminating waiver 2 and penalty provisions.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section l. Section 279.10, subsection l, Code 2015, is amended to read as follows:

1. The school year for each school district and accredited nonpublic school shall begin on July 1 and each regularly established elementaxy and secondaxy school shall begin ne sooner than a day during the calendar week in which the firgt day of September falls but no later than the first Monday in Decembex. However, if the firgt day of September fallo on a Sunday, school may begin on a day during the calendax week which immediately precedes the first day of September. The school calendar shall include not less than one hundred eighty days, except as provided in subsection 3 , or one thousand eighty hours of instruction during the calendar year. The board of directors of a school district and the authorities in charge of an accredited nonpublic school shall determine the school start date for the school calendar based on the best educational interests of the students and shall set the number of days or hours of required attendance for the school year as provided in section 299.l, subsection 2 , but the board of directors of a school district shall hold a public hearing on any proposed school calendar prior to adopting the school calendar. If the board of directors of a district or the authorities in charge of an accredited nonpublic school extends the school calendar because inclement weather caused the school district or accredited nonpublic school to temporarily close during the regular school calendar, the school district or accredited nonpublic school may excuse a graduating senior who has met district or school requirements for graduation from attendance during the extended school calendar. A school corporation may begin employment of personnel for in-service training and development purposes before the date to begin elementary and secondary school.

Sec. 2. Section 279.10, subsection 4, Code 2015, is amended by striking the subsection.

Sec. 3. REPEAL. Section 257.17, Code 2015, is repealed.
