## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the licensure of child care programs
- operated or contracted for by a school district or
- 3 accredited nonpublic school and including effective date
- 4 provisions.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 237A.1, subsection 3, paragraph b, Code
- 2 2015, is amended by striking the paragraph.
- 3 Sec. 2. Section 279.49, subsection 1, Code 2015, is amended 4 by striking the subsection.
- 5 Sec. 3. Section 279.49, subsections 2 and 3, Code 2015, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 2. The board of directors of a school corporation may
- 8 operate or contract for the operation of a program to provide
- 9 child care to children not enrolled in school or to students
- 10 enrolled in kindergarten through grade six before and after
- 11 school, or to both. Programs operated or contracted by a
- 12 board shall either meet standards for child care programs
- 13 adopted by the state board of education or shall be licensed
- 14 by the department of human services under chapter 237A as a
- 15 child care center unless the program is exempt from licensure
- 16 under chapter 237A. A program operated by a board under
- 17 contract which is not located on property owned or leased
- 18 by the board must be licensed by the department of human
- 19 services. Notwithstanding requirements of the department of
- 20 human services regarding space allocated to child care centers
- 21 licensed under chapter 237A, a program operated or contracted
- 22 by a board which is located on school grounds may define
- 23 alternative spaces, in policy and procedures, appropriate to
- 24 meet the needs of children in the program if the primary space
- 25 is required for another use.
- 26 3. a. The person employed to be responsible for a program
- 27 operated or contracted by a board that is not licensed by the
- 28 department of human services shall be an appropriately licensed
- 29 teacher under chapter 272 or shall meet other standards adopted
- 30 by the state board of education collaborate with that board in
- 31 the operation of that program.
- 32 b. An employee of a program operated or contracted by a
- 33 board shall be subject to a background investigation at least
- 34 once every five years after the employee's initial date of
- 35 hire.

- 1 Sec. 4. Section 280.3A, Code 2015, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 280.3A Accredited nonpublic school child care programs.
- 4 Authorities in charge of an accredited nonpublic schools
- 5 school may operate or contract for the operation of a child
- 6 care programs, as defined program, as described in section
- 7 279.49, subsection 1. The provisions of section 279.49 as
- 8 they relate to child care programs of a school corporation and
- 9 its board of directors apply to the child care programs of the
- 10 accredited nonpublic school and the authority in charge.
- 11 Sec. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE AND IMPLEMENTATION. This Act takes
- 12 effect January 1, 2016, except that the department of human
- 13 services may begin implementation prior to January 1, 2016, to
- 14 the extent necessary to transition to full implementation of
- 15 the provisions of this Act.
