**Rulemaking related to radiation safety requirements for industrial radiographic operations, particle accelerators for nonhuman use, analytical X-ray equipment, and well-logging**

The Department of Health and Human Services hereby rescinds Chapter 45, “Radiation Safety Requirements for Industrial Radiographic Operations, Particle Accelerators for Nonhuman Use, Analytical X-Ray Equipment, and Well-Logging,” Iowa Administrative Code.

*Legal Authority for Rulemaking*

This rulemaking is adopted under the authority provided in Iowa Code chapters 136B and 136C.

*State or Federal Law Implemented*

This rulemaking implements, in whole or in part, Iowa Code chapters 136B and 136C.

*Purpose and Summary*

This chapter is one of eight pertaining to radiologic health matters regulated by the Department. This chapter and the seven others were reviewed pursuant to Executive Order 10. As a result of this review, content from all the chapters was reorganized and this chapter is being rescinded.

*Public Comment and Changes to Rulemaking*

Notice of Intended Action for this rulemaking was published in the Iowa Administrative Bulletin on November 26, 2025, as **ARC 9744C**. Public hearings were held on the following date:

*Adoption of Rulemaking*

This rulemaking was adopted by the Department on March 11, 2026.

The Administrative Rules Review Committee, a bipartisan legislative committee which oversees rulemaking by executive branch agencies, may, on its own motion or on written request by any individual or group, review this rulemaking at its [regular monthly meeting](#) or at a special meeting. The Committee’s meetings are open to the public, and interested persons may be heard as provided in Iowa Code section 17A.8(6).

*Effective Date*

This rulemaking will become effective on July 1, 2026.
