Notice of Intended Action

Twenty-five interested persons, a governmental subdivision, an agency or association of 25 or more persons may demand an oral presentation hereon as provided in Iowa Code section 17A.4(1)“b.”

Notice is also given to the public that the Administrative Rules Review Committee may, on its own motion or on written request by any individual or group, review this proposed action under section 17A.8(6) at a regular or special meeting where the public or interested persons may be heard.

Pursuant to the authority of Iowa Code section 99B.2, the Department of Inspections and Appeals hereby gives Notice of Intended Action to rescind Chapter 102, “Social Gambling,” Iowa Administrative Code.

This proposed amendment implements changes to Iowa Code chapter 99B resulting from 2015 Iowa Acts, chapter 99 (Senate File 482), which made substantial updates and revisions to Iowa Code chapter 99B, including requirements for social gambling now found in Iowa Code sections 99B.41 to 99B.45. With these updated and new provisions in the Iowa Code, the Department has concluded that it is unnecessary at this time to supplement these Iowa Code provisions with administrative rules. Therefore, this amendment proposes to rescind and reserve Chapter 102.

The Department does not believe that the proposed amendment imposes any financial hardship on any regulated entity, body, or individual.
