Notice of Intended Action

Twenty-five interested persons, a governmental subdivision, an agency or association of 25 or more persons may demand an oral presentation hereon as provided in Iowa Code section 17A.4(1)“b.”

Notice is also given to the public that the Administrative Rules Review Committee may, on its own motion or on written request by any individual or group, review this proposed action under section 17A.8(6) at a regular or special meeting where the public or interested persons may be heard.

Pursuant to the authority of Iowa Code section 6B.2A(1)“f,” the Attorney General hereby gives Notice of Intended Action to amend Chapter 34, “Acquisition Negotiation Statement of Rights,” Iowa Administrative Code.

The limited purpose of the proposed amendment is to conform one provision in rule 61—34.1(6B) more closely to the statutory language appearing at 2017 Iowa Code section 6B.54(4).

Any interested person may make written suggestions or comments on the proposed amendment on or before June 13, 2017. Such written materials should be directed to David L. This amendment is intended to implement Iowa Code section 6B.2A(1)“f.”

The following amendment is proposed.

Amend rule **61—34.1(6B)**, Statement of property owner’s rights, by rescinding paragraph “**11**” and adopting the following **new** paragraph in lieu thereof:

11. A notice of the scheduling of construction or development of a public improvement which shall, to the greatest extent practicable, not require a person lawfully occupying the real property to move from a dwelling or to move the person’s business or farm operation without at least 90 days’ written notice of the date by which the move is required.
