Rule making related to five-year rules review

The Iowa Public Information Board (IPIB) hereby amends Chapter 2, “Complaint Investigation and Resolution Procedures,” and Chapter 4, “Contested Cases,” Iowa Administrative Code.

Legal Authority for Rule Making

This rule making is adopted under the authority provided in Iowa Code section 23.6(2).

State or Federal Law Implemented

This rule making implements, in whole or in part, Iowa Code chapter 23.

Purpose and Summary

This rule making reflects changes related to the IPIB five-year rules review and removes inapplicable rules.

Public Comment and Changes to Rule Making

Notice of Intended Action for this rule making was published in the Iowa Administrative Bulletin on September 21, 2022, as **ARC 6540C**. No public comments were received. No changes from the Notice have been made.

Adoption of Rule Making

This rule making was adopted by IPIB on October 26, 2022.

Fiscal Impact

This rule making has no fiscal impact to the State of Iowa.

Jobs Impact

After analysis and review of this rule making, no impact on jobs has been found.

Waivers
