CHAPTER 104

BOARD OF EDUCATIONAL EXAMINERS MEMBERSHIP H.F. 615

AN ACT relating to the membership of the board of educational examiners.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. Section 272.3, subsection 1, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2007, is amended to read as follows:

The board of educational examiners consists of <u>eleven twelve</u> members. Two must be members of the general public, <u>one must be the director of the department of education or the direc-</u><u>tor's designee</u>, and the remaining nine <u>members</u> must be licensed practitioners. One of the public members shall have served on a school board. The public members shall never have held a practitioner's license, but shall have a demonstrated interest in education. <u>One of the</u> <u>licensed practitioners shall be the director of the department of education or the director's des-</u><u>ignee</u>. The <u>remaining eight nine</u> practitioners shall be selected from the following areas and specialties of the teaching profession:

CHAPTER 105 CLARINDA CORRECTIONAL FACILITY — PURPOSE AND USE H.F. 759

AN ACT specifying the functions of the Clarinda correctional facility.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. Section 904.205, Code 2007, is amended to read as follows: 904.205 CLARINDA CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.

The state correctional facility at Clarinda shall be utilized as a secure men's correctional facility primarily for offenders with chemical dependence, mental retardation, or social inadequacies mental illness.
