Job Description:

Security Officers are responsible to provide a deterrent to acts of violence by preventing dangerous weapons, explosives, and other unauthorized items from entering the State Capitol building.

The role of the Security Officers is to monitor walk through traffic with the use of X-Ray machines, metal detectors, and hand held metal detecting wands to screen employees and visitors for weapons and unauthorized items before allowing access to the State Capitol building.

Minimum Qualification Requirements:

High school diploma or GED.

Additional Qualification Requirements:

Applicants with 5 years of law enforcement experience preferred, and must be able to pass a background check.
