

357H.1 Rural improvement zones.

1. The board of supervisors of a county with less than eighteen thousand five hundred residents, based upon the 1990 certified federal census, and with a private lake development shall designate an area surrounding the lake, if it is an unincorporated area of the county, a rural improvement zone upon receipt of a petition pursuant to section 357H.2, and upon the board's determination that the area is in need of improvements.

2. For purposes of this chapter, "*improvements*" means dredging, installation of erosion control measures, land acquisition, and related improvements, including soil conservation practices, within or outside of the boundaries of the zone.

For purposes of this chapter, "*board*" means the board of supervisors of the county.
