

237A.7 Confidential information.

Anyone who acquires through the administration of [this chapter](#) information relative to an individual in a child care facility or to a relative of the individual shall not, directly or indirectly, disclose the information except upon inquiry before a court of law or with the written consent of the individual or, in the case of a child, the written consent of the parent or guardian or as otherwise specifically required or allowed by law.

[This section](#) shall not prohibit the disclosure of information relative to the structure and operation of a facility nor shall it prohibit the statistical analysis by duly authorized persons of data collected by virtue of [this chapter](#), or the publication of the results of the analysis in a manner which does not disclose information identifying individual persons.
