

**222.64 Foreign state or country or unknown residency.**

If the residency of the person is determined by a county or the state to be in a foreign state or country or is determined to be unknown, the county or the state shall certify the determination to the administrator. The certification shall be accompanied by a copy of the evidence supporting the determination. The care of the person shall be as arranged by the county or the state or by an order as the court may enter. Application for admission or order of commitment may be made pending investigation by the administrator.
