

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS AND PUBLIC MEASURES, §49A.8§49A.8, CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS AND PUBLIC MEASURES49A.8Canvass — declaration of result — record.The judges of election, county boards of canvassers, and other election officials shall canvass the vote on any constitutional amendment or public measure, and make return thereof, in the same manner as required by law for the canvass and return of the vote for public officers.
