

904.603 Action for damages.

A person receiving or who has received services, or that person's family, victim, or employer may institute a civil action for damages under [chapter 669](#) or other action to restrain the release of confidential records set out in [section 904.602, subsection 2](#), which is in violation of that section. A person, agency, or governmental body proven to have released confidential records in violation of [section 904.602, subsection 2](#), is liable for actual damages for each violation and is liable for court costs and reasonable attorney's fees incurred by the party bringing the action.
