

914.7 Rights not restorable.

1. Notwithstanding any other provision of [this chapter](#), a person who has been convicted of a forcible felony, a felony violation of [chapter 124](#) involving a firearm, or a felony violation of [chapter 724](#) shall not have the person's rights of citizenship restored to the extent of allowing the person to receive, transport, or possess firearms.

2. Notwithstanding any provision of [this chapter](#), a person seventeen years of age or younger who commits a public offense involving a firearm which is an aggravated misdemeanor against a person or a felony shall not have the person's rights of citizenship restored to the extent of allowing the person to receive, transport, or possess firearms.
