CHAPTER 1  
GENERAL INFORMATION

**791—1.1(5) Duties.** The commission on uniform laws is established by Iowa Code sections 5.1 to 5.4 and is charged with the duties of (1) attending the meeting of the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws, (2) promoting uniformity in state laws when this is deemed desirable and practicable, and (3) reporting to the general assembly at each of its sessions.

**791—1.2(5) Implementation.** The commission functions by (1) attending the meeting of the national conference, (2) contacting members and committees of the general assembly, (3) reporting to the general assembly and the governor, (4) participating in the committee work of the national conference, and (5) informing members of the general public about the work of the national conference and receiving ideas from individuals.
