**282—13.14(272)** Specific requirements for a Class E license. A nonrenewable license valid for one year may be issued to an individual as follows:

**13.14(1)** *Expired license.* Based on an expired Class A, Class B, Class C, Class D or teacher exchange license, the holder of the expired license shall be eligible to receive a Class E license upon application and submission of all required materials.

**13.14(2)** *Application.* The application process will require transcripts of coursework completed during the term of the expired license, a program of study indicating the coursework necessary to obtain full licensure, and registration for coursework to be completed during the term of the Class E license. The Class E license will be denied if the applicant has not completed any coursework during the term of the Class B, Class C, or Class D license unless extenuating circumstances are verified.
