

481—37.1(137C) Building and grounds. Owners or managers are expected to keep hotels clean, meaning no litter nor accumulation of refuse anywhere on the premises. The floors, walls, and ceilings shall be kept clean and in good repair.

37.1(1) Screens, self-closing doors or other effective methods shall be used to keep flies, mosquitoes and other pests out of hotel lobbies, kitchens or any other indoor area.

37.1(2) All garbage must be kept in metal or plastic containers with tight-fitting lids and removed regularly to avoid offensive odors, a problem with insects or rodents, or health or fire hazards.

37.1(3) Any room or article that becomes infested with insects or vermin shall be cleaned or chemically treated until there are no more insects or vermin.

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
