

481—70.12(231D) Recertification process for an accredited program.

70.12(1) To obtain recertification, an accredited program shall comply with rule 481—70.9(231D) at least 30 calendar days prior to the expiration of the program's certification.

70.12(2) If the facility is in good standing, a full certification shall be issued for the term of the accreditation not to exceed three years, unless the certification is conditionally issued, suspended or revoked by either the department or the recognized accrediting entity. If the decision is to deny recertification, the department will provide the applicant an opportunity for hearing in accordance with rule 481—67.14(17A,231B,231C,231D).
