

481—70.2(231D) Program certification. A program may obtain certification by meeting all applicable requirements or being voluntarily accredited by a recognized accreditation entity.

70.2(1) Posting requirements. A program's current certificate shall be visibly displayed within the designated operation area of the program. The latest monitoring report, fire safety bureau report, and food establishment inspections report issued pursuant to Iowa Code chapter 137F shall be made available to the public by the program upon request.

70.2(2) Dementia-specific programs. If a program meets the definition of a dementia-specific adult day services program during two sequential certification monitorings, the program shall meet all requirements for a dementia-specific program, including the requirements set forth in rule 481—70.30(231D) and in subrule 70.32(2).
