

11—44.11(70A) Annual review of participating employees. During September of each year, each participating association must, if requested by the department, supply officials in charge of each affected payroll system with a certified list of all state employees who have a professional/trade association dues deduction. The list must contain the same information required in rule 11—44.2(70A), as the list will be used by the state to determine if the association continues to have 100 or more employees participating in the program.

If the minimum qualification is not being maintained, written notification may be provided to the association giving it 90 days to meet the minimum qualification. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the minimum qualification has not been attained, the dues deduction for all participating employees for that association may be terminated.
