

**481—704.2(148F,149,272C) Indiscriminately prescribing, administering or dispensing any drug for other than a lawful purpose.** The board may impose any of the disciplinary sanctions provided in 645—Chapter 13 when the board determines that the licensee is guilty of any of the following acts or offenses:

**704.2(1)** Self-prescribing or self-dispensing controlled substances.

**704.2(2)** Prescribing or dispensing controlled substances to members of the licensee's immediate family for an extended period of time.

*a.* Prescribing or dispensing controlled substances to members of the licensee's immediate family is allowable for an acute condition or on an emergency basis when the physician conducts an examination, establishes a medical record, and maintains proper documentation.

*b.* Immediate family includes spouse or life partner, natural or adopted children, grandparent, parent, sibling, or grandchild of the physician; and natural or adopted children, grandparent, parent, sibling, or grandchild of the physician's spouse or life partner.

**704.2(3)** Prescribing or dispensing controlled substances outside the scope of the practice of podiatry.
