

481—740.3(147) Educational qualifications.

740.3(1) The applicant shall possess the following:

a. A master's degree from an accredited school, college or university with a major in speech pathology; or

b. A master's or doctoral degree from an accredited school, college or university with a major in audiology.

740.3(2) Foreign-trained speech pathologists and audiologists will provide an equivalency evaluation at the licensee's expense of the licensee's educational credentials by one of the following: International Education Research Foundation, Inc., Credentials Evaluation Service. The professional curriculum must be equivalent to that stated in these rules.

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
