

701—1106.12(99G) Claim period. All prizes for games not associated with another state's lottery must be claimed as directed within 90 calendar days of the drawing in which the prize was won unless otherwise specified in the game specific rules. All prizes for games associated with another state's lottery are to be claimed as directed within the game specific rules. For purposes of determining the claim period, the drawing date is not counted. If a prize is claimed by mail, the lottery division must actually receive the ticket or share and claim form within the claim period. Any prize not properly claimed within the specified period is forfeited. The claim period for a game may be altered by the lottery division in the game specific rules.

This rule is intended to implement Iowa Code sections 99G.9(2), 99G.21, and 99G.31.
