650—14.4(147,153,272C) Late fee. Failure to renew the license prior to September 1 following expiration shall result in a late fee of \$100 being assessed by the board in addition to the renewal fee. Failure to renew prior to October 1 following expiration shall result in a late fee of \$150 being assessed.

- **14.4(1)** No renewal application shall be considered timely and sufficient until received by the board and accompanied by the material required for renewal and all applicable renewal and late fees.
- **14.4(2)** Failure of a licensee to renew a license prior to November 1 following expiration shall cause the license to lapse and become invalid. A licensee whose license has lapsed and become invalid is prohibited from the practice of dentistry or dental hygiene until the license is reinstated in accordance with rule 14.5(153).

This rule is intended to implement Iowa Code sections 147.10, 147.11, 153.30 and 272C.2.
