

193F—16.3(543D) Investigations. The board is authorized by Iowa Code sections 17A.13(1) and 543D.21 to conduct such investigations as are needed to determine whether grounds exist to make application to the district court pursuant to Iowa Code section 543D.21 or to impose civil penalties against a person who is not certified or registered with the board. Such investigations shall conform to the procedures outlined in 193F—Chapters 8 and 19. The board is authorized to issue subpoenas and to compel the testimony of witnesses in connection with such investigations, pursuant to Iowa Code section 543D.21. Complaint and investigatory files solely concerning persons who are not certified or registered by the board are not confidential except as provided in Iowa Code chapter 22.
