205—6.2(22) Communications from persons other than victims.

6.2(1) Written communication. Communications by a person other than a victim, as defined in rule 205-7.1(915), concerning an inmate, parolee, or work release shall be in writing so that the communication may readily be made a permanent part of the case file. Oral communications concerning an inmate, parolee, or work release by a person other than a victim will be heard only with the consent of the board.

6.2(2) *Disclosure to inmate.* The board shall place a written communication concerning an inmate, parolee, or work release in the case file.
