

481—2016.6(543B) Reactivating an inactive license. A license may be renewed without the necessary continuing education, but it is only renewed to an inactive status. Prior to reactivating a license that has been issued inactive due to failure to submit evidence of continuing education, the licensee submits evidence that all deficient continuing education hours have been completed. Licensees who complete continuing education hours in excess of the requirements for renewal may apply up to 50 percent of the required hours to the following renewal period. Licensees may apply a maximum of 18 hours from the previous renewal period. Licensees cannot carry over any hours toward the mandatory eight-hour law update course nor the four-hour ethics course.
