

481—616.5(152) Conditional approval.

616.5(1) Conditional approval may be granted if the board determines that the program does not meet the criteria for approval at any time during the progression of the program.

616.5(2) The board:

a. Will notify the president of the academic institution and head of the nursing program, in writing, of the program's conditional approval status. The nursing program will be given a reasonable period of time to submit an action plan to correct the identified program deficiencies.

b. May request progress reports and conduct a site visit at any time during the conditional approval.

616.5(3) The program shall notify all students and prospective students of the program's conditional approval status.

616.5(4) Prior to the expiration of a program's conditional approval, representatives of the program and controlling institution shall submit a systemic evaluation plan detailing how outcomes are met. The board determines whether to grant the program full approval, extend conditional approval, or initiate proceedings to deny or withdraw approval.

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
