

481—616.7(152) Closure of an approved program.

616.7(1) Prior to program closure, the controlling institution shall submit a written plan to the board. The plan shall include:

- a.* Reasons for closure and the date of closure, including when the last student graduates.
- b.* Provisions to continually meet the criteria for board approval and maintenance of nursing education standards during the transition to closure.
- c.* Arrangements for enrolled students to complete a board-approved program.

616.7(2) Prior to closure, the controlling institution shall notify the board regarding the location and maintenance of student and graduate transcripts and records.
