

481—475.2(88B) Permit application procedures.

475.2(1) *Application.* To apply for or to renew a permit, a business entity shall complete and submit the form provided by the department. All requested applicable information and attachments must be provided. A \$500 nonrefundable application fee shall accompany each permit application.

475.2(2) *Action on application.* A new permit is valid for one year from the date of issuance. A renewal permit is valid for one year from the expiration date of the applicant's prior permit. A permit may be denied for the reasons set forth in rule 481—475.8(17A,88B,252J,272D) or if the application package is incomplete. Within 60 days of receiving a completed application package for a new permit, the department will issue a permit or deny the application. Within 30 days of receiving a completed application package for a permit renewal, the department will issue a permit or deny the application. Applications received after expiration of a prior permit will be considered applications for new permits rather than renewals.
