

701—2506.20(17A) Hearing procedures.

2506.20(3) Parties have the right to participate or to be represented in all hearings or prehearing conferences related to their case. Partnerships, corporations, limited-liability companies, and associations may be represented by any member, officer, director, or duly authorized agent. Any party may be represented by an attorney or another person authorized by law. An attorney admitted pro hoc vice in accordance with the Iowa Court Rules to practice in an agency administrative action in accordance with Iowa Court Rule 31.14 is obligated to have an in-state attorney present at every interaction with the presiding officer. For matters related to Iowa Code chapters 421 through 453E, Iowa Code section 421.59 and rule 701—8.8(17A,22,421,422) govern who may represent a party.
