

199—17.6(475A,476) Compilation and billing of assessment.

17.6(1) The commission shall determine its own expenses to be billed and shall add the certified expenses incurred by the consumer advocate. The commission does not review the expenses certified to it by the consumer advocate.

17.6(2) Unless otherwise ordered by the commission, bills must be paid within 30 days of receipt unless an objection is filed in writing pursuant to Iowa Code section 476.10. In the event an objection is filed under rule 199—17.10(475A,476), the portion of the bill not contested must be paid within 30 days of receipt. The commission shall develop procedures for the collection of unpaid bills.

17.6(3) A person participating in a commission proceeding or matter may file a request in that proceeding or matter for the commission to determine how the expenses of that proceeding or matter will be assessed.
