

281—84.4(256) Appeal of denial of a registration fee reimbursement award or an NBC annual award. Any applicant may appeal the denial of a registration fee reimbursement award or an NBC annual award to the director of the department. Appeals will be in writing, signed, and notarized; will contain a short and plain statement of the reasons for appeal; will be based on a contention that the process was conducted outside statutory authority or violated state or federal law, regulation or rule; and will be received within ten working days of the date of the notice of denial. The hearing and appeal procedures found in 7—Chapter 2506 that govern the director’s decisions will apply to proceedings under this rule. The director’s decision is due within a reasonable time, not to exceed 30 days from the date of the hearing.
