701—256.13(81GA,HF339) Permit issuance fee. Retail permits are issued by the following authorities at the following prices:

256.13(1) Outside any city, by the county board of supervisors, at an annual cost of \$50.

256.13(2) In cities of less than 15,000 population, by the city council, at an annual cost of \$75.

256.13(3) In cities of 15,000 or more population, by the city council, at an annual cost of \$100.

256.13(4) If any permit is granted during the month of October, November, or December, the fee shall be three-fourths of the above maximum schedule; if granted during the month of January, February, or March, one-half of the maximum schedule; and if granted during the month of April, May, or June, one-fourth of the maximum schedule.

256.13(5) The retail permit expires on June 30 of each year. The city or county must submit a copy of any retail permit issued and the application for the permit to the department of public health within 30 days of issuance.
