701—271.7(422E) Bonds. Negotiable, interest-bearing school bonds may be issued by the school district's board of directors without an election. Revenues from tax imposed under this chapter must be used to repay principal and interest of these bonds. Proceeds from these bonds must be used only for school infrastructure needs as defined in this chapter. These bonds may only be issued by a school district that has imposed tax under this chapter. The maximum period for principal on bonds to be payable cannot exceed the date of repeal stated in the ballot proposition. [ARC 6508C, IAB 9/7/22, effective 10/12/22]
