701—273.1(15J) Purpose. The economic development authority board is authorized by the general assembly and the governor to oversee the implementation and administration of certain provisions of a new economic development program known as the Iowa reinvestment Act, which was enacted in 2013 Iowa Acts, House File 641. The program provides for as much as \$100 million in state hotel and motel and state sales tax revenues from new revenue-generating projects in certain districts to be reinvested within those districts. In general, the economic development authority has the responsibility to evaluate projects and make funding decisions, while the department of revenue has the responsibility for collecting the tax revenues used to fund projects under the program and making payments to municipalities. This chapter sets forth the department of revenue's administration of the calculation of the state sales tax and hotel and motel tax funding and the remittance of such funding to governmental entities. The administrative rules for other aspects of the Iowa reinvestment Act may be found in the economic development authority's rules at 261—Chapter 200.
