## 441—53.6(79GA,HF732) Termination of rent subsidy payments.

**53.6(1)** *Reasons for termination.* The rent subsidy shall terminate at the end of the month in which any of the following occur and a notice shall be sent which states the reason for the termination:

*a.* The person does not meet one or more of the eligibility criteria listed in rule 441—53.2(79GA,HF732).

- b. The person dies.
- c. Completion of the required documentation is not received.
- *d.* No further funds are available for the rent subsidy program.

**53.6(2)** *Reporting of changes.* The person is required to report to the bureau of long-term care within ten working days any changes which may affect eligibility. Failure to do so may result in responsibility for repayment of funds and termination of the subsidy. (See rule 441—53.7(79GA,HF732).)

**53.6(3)** *Insufficient funding.* If funds are not sufficient to cover payments for all persons on the subsidy, persons shall be terminated from the subsidy in inverse order to the dates they began receiving payments, i.e., the last person to be added to the subsidy being the first person to be removed. The person terminated shall move back to the waiting list with the person's original application date dictating the person's position on the waiting list as stated at subrule 53.3(4). The bureau of long-term care is responsible for notifying the persons who will be removed from the subsidy for this reason.
