701—24.10(272D) Decision of the unit.

24.10(1) If the unit mails a notice to a person and the person requests a conference, the unit shall issue a written decision if any of the following conditions exist:

- a. The person fails to appear at a scheduled conference.
- b. A conference is held and the unit makes a decision based upon that conference.
- c. The obligor fails to comply with a written agreement entered into by the obligor and the unit.
- **24.10(2)** Mailing of decision. The unit shall send a copy of the written decision to the person by regular mail at the person's most recent address of record. If the decision is made to issue a certificate of noncompliance or to withdraw the certificate of noncompliance, a copy of the certificate of noncompliance or of the withdrawal of the certificate of noncompliance shall be attached to the written decision
 - **24.10(3)** Contents of decision. The written decision shall state all of the following:
- a. That the certificate of noncompliance or withdrawal of the certificate of noncompliance has been mailed to the licensing authorities named in the notice provided by the unit.
- b. That upon receipt of a certificate of noncompliance, the licensing authority shall initiate proceedings to suspend, revoke, deny issuance, or deny renewal of a license, unless the licensing authority receives a withdrawal of a certificate of noncompliance from the unit.
- c. That in order to obtain a withdrawal of a certificate of noncompliance from the unit, the obligor shall enter into a written agreement with the unit, comply with an existing written agreement with the unit, or pay the total amount of liability owed.
- d. That if the unit issues a written decision which includes a certificate of noncompliance, the person may request a hearing before the district court. The person may retain an attorney at the person's own expense to represent the person at the hearing. The district court's review shall be limited to mistakes of fact surrounding the amount of the liability owed or the identity of the person. [Editorial change: IAC Supplement 11/2/22]
