701—284.22(422,423) Modular homes. On and after July 1, 1988, 40 percent of the gross receipts from the sale of a modular home is exempt from tax. A "modular home" is any structure, built in a factory, made to be used as a place for human habitation which cannot be attached or towed behind a motor vehicle and which does not have permanently attached to its body or frame any wheels or axles.

This rule is intended to implement Iowa Code section 422.45.
