**761—480.1(321) Definitions.** The definitions in Iowa Code section 321.1 and subsection 321.89(1) apply to this chapter. In addition:

"*Abandoned vehicle*," when used in Iowa Code section 321.89 and this chapter of rules, means only those vehicles subject to registration as referred to in Iowa Code section 321.18.

"Bidder registry" means a record of all persons who have registered to bid at a public auction.

"*Public auction*," when used in Iowa Code section 321.89, means an auction open to the general public. A public auction may be by electronic means, by sealed bid, or a conventional oral auction. The highest bidder is awarded the property. When the auction is a conventional oral auction, bidders shall register and bring the bid deposit with them to the auction on the day and at the location and time specified for the sale, if a bid deposit is required.
