

721—21.362(49) Precinct election officials and other election personnel training requirements.

21.362(1) The commissioner shall conduct, not later than the day before each election, a training course necessary and appropriate to the roles of all election personnel. The personnel shall include all precinct election officials and any other persons who will be employed in or around the polling places on election day by the commissioner. For purposes of this rule, election day includes any voting at the commissioner's office or a satellite location.

21.362(2) The training that is necessary and appropriate to the roles of election personnel, which the commissioner may combine with election-specific materials, shall include subjects established yearly in policy by the state commissioner. Once a year, all precinct election officials shall receive a complete annual training, and before every election all precinct election officials shall receive a refresher training course.

This rule is intended to implement Iowa Code chapter 49.
