

**641—9.4(135) Application procedures for American Diabetes Association-recognized and American Association of Diabetes Educators-accredited programs.** When a program is recognized by the American Diabetes Association or accredited by the American Association of Diabetes Educators, the program shall apply for certification to the department by submitting a copy of the Certificate of Recognition provided by ADA or the Certificate of Accreditation provided by AADE, the name, address and telephone number for the program, the name of the program coordinator and the name of the program physician. In addition, since the ADA recognition and the AADE accreditation programs do not require the participation of a pharmacist but the Iowa law does, ADA-recognized and AADE-accredited programs shall submit the name(s), license number(s) and continuing education hours of the pharmacist(s) who serves as program staff. A pharmacist shall be a primary or supporting instructor or advisory committee member and shall meet the education requirements in 9.8(6), 9.8(7) or 9.8(8).
