All applications are submitted in a manner directed by the department; address the standards found in rules 281—16.2(256C), 281—16.3(256C), and 281—16.9(256C); and contain a plan describing how they will fully meet the program standards within one year of the funding award. Points are awarded based on the applicant's provision of the following information:

- 1. Preschool program summary;
- 2. Research documentation;
- 3. Identification and documentation of local population;
- 4. Needs assessment of local programs providing services;
- 5. Evidence of collaboration with local agencies to provide comprehensive services; and
- 6. Letters of community support.
